#### Historic Win for Irish Celtic Team



Irish Celtic Track & Field International Teams 2014

The 2014 Celtic Games were held in Morton Stadium, Santry on Saturday 9<sup>th</sup> August. Hosted by Athletics Ireland, it proved to be a historic occasion for Ireland whose athletes performed a clean sweep of the seven Celtic trophies emerging as best overall country on the day. Ireland had a tremendous competition finishing 1<sup>st</sup> overall on 184 points with Wales in 2<sup>nd</sup> place on 150 points & Scotland in 3<sup>rd</sup> place with 136 points. An integral part of the Irish team was our 16 Munster athletes that lined out for their country & our 10 athletes that formed part of the Irish Development Team. 19 individual medals in total (7 gold, 8 silver & 4 bronze) were won by Munster. 3 Munster athletes also set new Celtic records on the day, namely **Orlaith O'Brien** in the Girls U/16 Javelin, **Kelly Ann Doyle** in the Girls U/18 400mH & **Daniel Ryan** in the Boys U/16 100mH & the Mixed U/16 4 x 100m Relay.

There were gold medal wins for **Orlaith O'Brien, Ferrybank A.C.** in the Girls U/16 Javelin (45.03m) CPB; **Daniel Ryan, Moycarkey Coolcroo A.C.** in the Boys U/16 100mH CBP 13.58; **Kelly Ann Doyle**, Carrick-On-Suir A.C. in the U/18 Girls 400mH CBP 62.85; **Maria Carey, Newport A.C.** in the U/18 Girls Triple Jump who equalled the Celtic Record of 11.98m; **Clodagh O'Mahony, Dooneen A.C.** in the U/18 Girls 100mH (15.43); **Scott Gibson**, Bandon A.C. in the U/18 Boys 400m (48.44); **Juri Kanash, West Waterford A.C.** in the U/18 Boys Pole Vault (4.15m); the Irish Mixed U/16 4 x 100m Relay Team (**Daniel Ryan**) 45.42 CBP & the Irish U/18 Boys 4 x 400m Relay Team (**Michael Quilligan**) 3.18.79.

Girls 4 x 400m Relay Team (**Jenna Bromell, Kelly Ann Doyle & Aoife Delargy**) 3.51.30 & the Irish U/18 Boys 4 x 100m Relay Team (**Jason Foley**) 42.89. **Laura Cussen, Old Abbey A.C.** had a 3<sup>rd</sup> place finish in the U/18 Women's Pole Vault (2.60m) with **Sean Collins, Ennis Track A.C.** placing 4<sup>th</sup> in the U/18 Men's 2km Steeplechase.

In the Relay competitions, **Daniel Ryan** was part of the Irish Mixed U/16 4 x 100m Relay team who won gold in a new Celtic Record time of 45.42, **Jenna Bromell, Kelly Ann Doyle & Aoife Delargy, Templemore A.C.** won silver with the Irish U/18 Girls 4 x 400m Relay, **Michael Quilligan** was on the winning U/18 Boys 4 x 400m Relay team.

Our athletes on the Irish Development Team also performed strongly with silver medals for **Sharlene Mawdsley, Newport A.C.** in the Girls U/18 200m, **Fiona O'Shea, Dooneen A.C.** in the Girls U/18 Triple Jump & **Tony Odubote, Ennis Track A.C.** who was on the Mixed U/16 4 x 100m Relay team. There were 3<sup>rd</sup> place finishes for **Tony Odubote** in the Boys U/16 200m, **Ciara Mockler, Moycarkey Coolcroo A.C.** in the Girls U/18 Shot Putt, **Killian Cullagh, Nenagh Olympic A.C.** in the Boys U/18 2km Steeplechase & **Stephen Walsh, Ferrybank A.C.** as part of the Boys U/18 4 x 100m Relay team. **Ellen Larkin, Emerald A.C.** (U/18 Pole Vault), **Aoife Doyle, Star of the Laune A.C.** (U/18 Discus) & **Maeve Aherne, Leevale A.C.** (U/18 1500m) all recorded 4<sup>th</sup> place finishes in their events along with Sharlene Mawdsley who was on the U/18 Girls 4 x 100m Relay team.

# Irish Team Reign Supreme at the 2014 Celtic Games

The Celtic Games took place in Morton Stadium, Santry on Saturday, 9th of August with Ireland, Wales, Scotland and the Athletics Ireland Development Team taking part. Athletes from each team compete in the U16 and U18 age groups over a range of track and field events. On a momentous day for Irish underage athletics the Irish team came out on top with a combined score of 184 points. Wales finished second on 160 points with Scotland third on 136 points.

At U16 level Ireland were buoyed by impressive victories by Kevin McGrath (1500m), Daniel Ryan (100m H), Mixed Relay, Robbie Marrs (High Jump), Molly Scott (80m H), Lauren Gleeson (Long Jump) and Orlaith O'Brien (Javelin).

## U18

At U18 level Joseph Ojemumi had a fine victory for the development team as he won the 100m in a time of 11.50 which was run into a -6.8 wind. Scott Gibson stormed to victory for Ireland in the 400m in a fast 48.44 seconds as Mustaffa Nasir brought the crowd to their feet to win an exciting 800m in a time of 1.56.91.

Gary Campbell also of the development team was a classy winner of the 1500m in a time of 3.59.04.

Donogh Mahon was over 2m in the High Jump as Jurjis Kanash in the Pole Vault also secured maximum points for Ireland. Jordan Hoang was the only athlete over 13m in the Triple Jump as he dominated the competition to win with a jump of 13.68.

Hoang, Jordan Amy Hamill battled hard in the 800m to take victory in a time of 2.14.42. There was double success for Ireland in the hurdles with Clodagh O'Mahony (100m H) and Kelly Ann Doyle (400m H) both bagging maximum points in their respective events.

Maria Casey was a class apart in the Triple Jump as she eased to victory with a jump of 11.98m. Annie Stafford was another of those impressing in the jumps as she jumped 5.78m for victory.

As always the 4x400m relays provided a thrilling conclusion to the day's action with the boy's U18 team coming from behind to secure victory in a time of 3.18.79
