The Munster Juvenile Combined Events Championships were held in a wet & windy Waterford RSC on Monday 5th May with competition for U/11 to Youth (U/17 & U/18) age groups. All 6 Munster counties were represented with 55 boys & 50 girls taking part with the biggest entries in the U/11 & U/12 age categories. With 14 Munster titles up for decision on the day, **St. Mary's A.C. Limerick** topped the Girls's list with 3 gold medal wins followed by **Liscarroll A.C., Ferrybank A.C., Carrig na Bhfear A.C. & St. John's A.C. Clare** with one each. Competition was more evenly divided for the Boys with one gold medal win each for **Waterford A.C., Moycarkey Coolcroo A.C., Liscarroll A.C., Bandon A.C., Nenagh Olympic A.C., Old Abbey A.C. & Riverstick/Kinsale A.C.**

Reigning National & Munster Combined Events Indoor Champions, **Sophie Meredith, St. Mary's A.C.** Limerick (Girls U/14), Vickie Cusack, Liscarroll A.C. (Girls U/15) & Daniel Ryan, Moycarkey Coolcroo A.C. (Boys U/16) all continued great form adding Munster Outdoor titles to their list of winnings for 2014. Aisling Cassidy, Bandon A.C. who was a bronze medal winner at the National Indoor Championships & silver winner in the Munster Indoor Championships also added another bronze medal to her collection in the Girls U/14 competition.

2 Championship Best Performances were also recorded on the day by the following athletes:-

- **Sophie Meredith, St. Mary's A.C.** jumped 1.56m in the Girls U/14 High Jump to break the existing record of 1.55m set by Rachel Clancy, St. John's A.C. Clare in 2010.
- Daniel Ryan, Moycarkey Coolcroo A.C. set a new record in the Boys U/16 Long Jump when he leaped out to 6.82m to smash the existing record of 6.26m set by Eoin O'Carroll, Tralee Harriers A.C. in 2010.

Laura Frawley, St. Mary's Limerick won the Girls U/11 competition (772 points) with Nicole Lapiy, Carrick-On-Suir A.C. in 2nd place (752) & Nessa Towey, Templemore A.C. in 3rd place (722). Praise Oweye, Ferrybank A.C. took the title in the Girls U/12 (1453) with Susan Nestor, St. Mary's A.C. Clare in 2nd place (1428) & Rachel Walsh, Ferrybank A.C. in 3rd place (1178). St. Mary's A.C., Limerick took their 2nd Munster title in the Girls U/13 with Niamh Foley winning gold (1449), her team-mate Holly Meredith winning silver (1423) & Anna Ryan, Moycarkey Coolcroo A.C. winning bronze (1259). There was a third title for St. Mary's A.C. Limerick in the Girls U/14 competition with gold for Sophie Meredith (2964), silver for Fiona Doyle, Star of the Laune A.C. (2687) & bronze for Aisling Cassidy, Bandon A.C. (2315).

Vickie Cusack, Liscarroll A.C. won the Girls U/15 title (2925), Laura Nicholson, Bandon A.C. was in 2nd place (2275) with team-mate Moira Barrett in 3rd place (2196). In the Girls U/16 competition, there was gold for Avril Braham, Carrig na Bhfear A.C. (2188), silver for Sinead O'Regan, Ferrybank A.C. (2100) & bronze for Tara Bradley, St. John's A.C. (1994. Cliodha Blake, St. John's A.C. won the Youth Girls competition (2166) with Rachel Clancy, St. John's A.C. Clare in 2nd place (1944) & Grace Furlong, Waterford A.C. in 3rd place (1801).
