13 Record Breaking Performances at Munster Indoor Championship

The Munster U/9 to U/13 Indoor Championships took place in Nenagh Indoor Stadium on Saturday 8th & Sunday 9th February 2014. It was a record breaking weekend with 13 new Championship Best Performances ("CBP's) being set over the 2 days, 8 by the girls & 5 by the boys. Highlights of the weekend were **Niamh Foley's (St. Mary's A.C.)** run in the Girls U/13 60m when she clocked a super fast time of 8.19 to smash Sarah Lavin's 2006 record of 8.41. Niamh now holds Munster Indoor Sprint records in U/10, U/11, U/12 & U/13 & she will be an athlete to watch for the future. **Diarmuid Healy, Midleton A.C.** was another athlete in great form when he ran 1.53.26 in the Boys U/11 600m shaving over 4 seconds off the existing record as well as **Maeve O'Neill's (Doheny A.C.)** performance in the Girls U/11 600m race where she who took almost 4 seconds off the record. Another super performance came from **Nathan Cremin, St. Mary's A.C.** who won the Boys U/12 600m breaking a 10 year old record by over a second.

Record breaking performers over the Championships were:-

- Holly O'Boyle, Marian A.C. who ran 56.87 in the Girls U/9 300m to break the 2012 record of 57.61 set by Maeve O'Neill, Doheny A.C.
- **Kate O'Regan, Riverstick/Kinsale A.C.** who jumped 3.65m in the Girls U/10 Long Jump to break the existing record of 3.64m set by Ellen Lynch, Dooneen A.C. in 2011.
- Maeve O'Neill, Doheny A.C. who ran 1.55.12 in the Girls U/11 600m to better the existing record of 1.59.08 held by Ellen Lynch, Dooneen A.C. set in 2012.
- Megan Lenihan, North Cork A.C. threw 9.18m in the Girls U/12 Shot Putt to break the existing record of 9.07m held by Sophie Meredith, St. Mary's A.C. & set in 2012.
- Ellen Lynch, Dooneen A.C. ran 9.92 in the Girls U/13 Hurdles to break Miriam Daly's (Carrick-On-Suir A.C.) record of 10.20 set in 2013.
- **Niamh Foley, St. Mary's A.C.** ran 8.19 in the Girls U/13 60m to take Sarah Lavin's 2006 record of 8.41
- Ciara Sheehy, Liscarroll A.C. threw 11.37m in the Girls U/13 Shot Putt to break the existing record of 11.00m set by Sophie Meredith, St. Mary's A.C. set in 2013.
- **Kyle Ettoh, Grange Fermoy A.C.** ran 9.07 in the Boys U/10 60m to break the existing record of 9.12 held by Kelvin O'Carroll, Dooneen set in 2013.
- Cian Hodgins, Nenagh Olympic A.C. ran 1.35.77 in the Boys U/10 500m to break the existing record of 1.39.49 held by Jack Corcoran, Waterford A.C. set in 2013.
- **Diarmuid Healy, Midleton A.C.** set a new record of 1.53.26 in the Boys U/11 600m to smash the 2012 record of 1.57.33 held by Ben Whelehan, Kilmurray/Ibrickane A.C.
- Nathan Cremin, St. Mary's A.C. ran 1.49.29 to break the 2004 record held by Jamie Moloney, Templemore A.C. of 1.50.81.
- Wymin Sivakamur, Leevale A.C. ran 9.81 in the Boys U/13 60mH to break Daniel Ryan's (Moycarkey Coolcroo A.C.) record of 10.01 set in 2011.
