6 Munster athletes were selected for Ireland for the SIAB Schools Cross Country International on Saturday 22<sup>nd</sup> March in Bolton, England –

**Caoimhe Harrington, West Muskerry A.C.** representing her school **Colaiste Pobail, Bheantraí** put in a terrific performance to lead the field home in the Junior Girls race winning individual gold & leading the Irish team to a bronze medal in the team competition which included **Laura Nicholson, Bandon Grammer School (Bandon A.C.)** who finished 25<sup>th</sup> overall.



**Fiona Everard, Maria Immaculate CC Dunmanway (Bandon A.C.)** won a bronze team medal with the Irish team in the Intermediate competition coming home in 22<sup>nd</sup> place overall.

**Kevin Mulcaire, Ennis Track A.C.** representing his school, **St. Flannan's Ennis** took silver in the Intermediate Boys race with a wonderful display of running & led his team home to a silver medal victory in the team competition which included fellow Munster men, **Fearghal Curtin, Midleton CBS (Youghal A.C.)** who was 13<sup>th</sup> overall & **Barry Keane, St. Declan's, Kilmacthomas** in 17<sup>th</sup> place. “There were thrilling individual victories achieved by two young Irish athletes; Caoimhe Harrington (Colaiste Pobail, Bheanntrai , Bantry) and Paddy Maher (Dunshaughlin Community College) at the SIAB International Schools Cross Country event in Bolton and there was silver and bronze medal success too by Kevin Mulcaire (St Flannan’s Ennis) and James Maguire (St Benildus, Dublin) in their respective Intermediate and Junior Boys events.

Caoimhe Harrington delivered a top drawer performance to win the Junior Girls race in a close finish with England’s Josie Czura who she just edged out approaching the finish line. Harrington also led the Irish Junior Women team to a third place finish behind England and Scotland.

This early victory by Caoimhe Harrington helped to inspire Paddy Maher to achieve victory in the Junior Boys event. Maher, who was running in his first international, raced into an early lead and was closely followed by his Irish schools team-mate James Maguire. However, it was Maher who had the faster turn of pace and he soon surged clear of England’s Matthew Willis and James Maguire and went on to finish strongly. The Irish Junior Boys team, led by Maher and Maguire, won the silver medals behind England. It was a day of special celebration for the Maher family as Paddy’s father, Tommy Maher is a former Irish Senior international cross-country runner who also finished third in the Dublin Marathon on two occasions.

The intermediate Girls race was a very convincing display by the English team with the first 8 individuals home all part of the English team. Ireland managed to hold off Wales to take Bronze in the Team results.

The final race of the day was the Intermediate Boys event and here Kevin Mulcaire from St Flannan’s College in Ennis delivered another top-class performance to take the silver medal behind the winner, Ben Dijkstra of England. Mulcaire led the Irish team to silver medal success behind England and ahead of Scotland.”
