Darragh McElhinney, Bantry A.C. finished 16th overall in the U/17 & U/20 race & was 5th in the U/17 race with **Michael Power, West Waterford A.C.** 30th & 14th U/17, **Charlie O'Donovan, Leevale A.C.** in 31st & 15th in U/17 race with **Eoin Looney, Kilmurray/Ibrickane A.C.** in 34th overall & an 18th place finish in the U/17 race. **Sean Curran, West Waterford A.C.** was 21st overall & 13th U/20 with **Barry Keane, Waterford A.C.** in 22nd & 14th U/20.

The event was run in conjunction with the Leinster Junior and Senior Cross Country Championships in CowPark, Dunboyne.
