Overall Win for Irish Celtic Team



Irish Celtic Track & Field International Teams 2017

The 2017 Celtic Games International, was held on home ground in Morton Stadium, Santry on Saturday 5th August 2017. The Irish team won 6 out of the 7 Celtic trophies and were the overall winners finishing on 188 points with Scotland in 2nd on 159 points and Wales in 3rd place on 146 points. A total of <u>30</u> athletes from Munster competed on the day with <u>18</u> Munster athletes part of the Irish team and a further <u>12</u> Munster athletes on the Irish Development team.

In the U/16 competitions, there was gold medals for Ciara Kennelly, Killarney Valley A.C. in the High Jump (1.68m) and Ciara Sheehy, Liscarroll A.C. in the Discus (33.66m). Daniel Hurley, Leevale A.C. was 2nd in the Long Jump (6.16m) with Wymin Sivakumar, Leevale A.C. (Development Team) in 3rd place with 6.13m. Mervyn Shalemba, Tralee Harriers A.C. (Development Team) was 2nd in the 100m (11.30), Shane Cawley, Waterford A.C. (Development Team) was 2nd in the Shot Putt with a throw of 14.23m with Nikolka Stevankova, Dooneen A.C. 3rd in the 200m (26.13). Aimee Hayde, Newport A.C. was 3rd in the 1500m (4.40.23) and Tommy Connolly, Leevale A.C. (Development Team) was also 3rd in the 800m (2.00.42). Nikolka Stevankova was also part of the Irish Mixed 4 x 100m Relay that won silver on the day in a time of 47.15.





In the U/18 competitions, there was top podium finishes for Sean Mockler, Moycarkey Coolcroo A.C. in the Hammer (60.92m), Sophie Meredith, St. Mary's A.C. Limerick in the Long Jump (5.56m), Katie Moynihan, Leevale A.C. in the Javelin (43.08m), Shane Monagle, Tramore A.C. in the 100mH (14.21), Laura Nicholson, Bandon A.C. in the Steeplechase (5.00.98), Miriam Daly, Carrick-On-Suir A.C. in the 400m and 4 x 400m Relay (3.51.47) and Tony Odubote, Ennis Track A.C. in the 400m (48.99) and the 4 x 400m (3.21.61). Silver medals were won by Padraig O'Callaghan, Leevale A.C. (Development Team) in the Hammer (54.00m), Emma Coffey, Carraig naBhfear A.C. (Pole Vault 3.21m), Sean Carolan, Nenagh Olympic A.C. (Development Team) in the Long Jump (6.43m), Ryan O'Leary, Leevale A.C. and Dave McInerney, Bandon A.C. in the 4 x 100m Relay (42.92) and Katie Murphy, Ferrybank A.C. (Development Team) in the 100m (12.37). Bronze medals were won by Clodagh Walsh, Abbey Striders A.C. in the Pole Vault (3.11m), Aisling Cassidy, Bandon A.C. in the Triple Jump (10.78m), Jo Keane, Ennis Track A.C. in the 800m (2.15.47) & Ryan O'Leary, Leevale A.C. in the 200m (22.54). 4th place finishes were recorded by Irish Development team athletes, Vickie Cusack, Liscarroll A.C. in the Long Jump (5.39m), Tirna Cahill, Youghal A.C. in the Hammer (47.80m), Conor Ryan, Templemore A.C. in the 1500m (4.08.87), Shawn Benson, Ennis Track A.C. in the 100m (11.28) and the 4 x 100m Relay (43.50) and Gabriel Kehinde, Ennis Track A.C. in the 4 x 100m Relay.

Ireland won the overall team title at the Celtic Games with a number of excellent performances in Morton Stadium yesterday.

Ireland tallied 188 points overall to top Scotland and Wales on the podium.

There was a host of star performers. In the girls' ranks some of the winners were Laura Nicholson (Bandon) with 5:00.98 in the 1500m steeplechase, Miriam Daly (Carrick on Suir) clocking 56.36 in the 400m, and Jade Williams (Shercock) in the hammer with 61.09m.

Among the boys were Jack Mitchell (SLOT) winning the 400m hurdles in 55.79, James Kelly (Finn Valley) with 18.12m in the shot put, and Tony Odubote (Ennis Track) winning the 400m in 48.99.

This culminates a busy juvenile season where a number of the athletes have also competed in the Schools International, European U20 Championships and European Youth Olympics.
