In the Field events, **Amy Whelan, Liscarroll A.C.** won double gold in the Girls U/14 Shot Putt & Javelin; **Megan Lenihan, North Cork A.C.** won treble gold in the Girls U/15 Discus, Shot Putt & Javelin setting two new CBP's in the Discus and Javelin; **Katie Nolke, Ferrybank A.C.** won double gold in the Girls U/14 High Jump and Long Jump setting a new record of 1.57m in the High Jump; **Sophie Meredith, St. Mary's A.C. Limerick** won treble gold in the Girls U/17 Long Jump, Triple Jump and Shot Putt setting a new record of 5.88m in the Long Jump; **Vickie Cusack, Liscarroll A.C.** won treble gold in the Shot Putt, Long Jump and 400mH; **Leah Parker, Midleton A.C.** won double gold in the Discus and Hammer setting a new CBP and **Ciara Sheehy, Liscarroll A.C.** won 4 gold medals in the Girls U/16 Shot Putt, Discus, Hammer & Javelin setting a new CBP's in the Shot Putt.

In the Boys sprint events, Glory Wenegieme, Belgooly A.C. won double gold in the Boys U/14 100m & 200m setting a new record of 24.49 in the 200m; Conor Commane, Tralee Harriers A.C. won double gold in the Boys U/15 100m & 200m and also added gold in the Long Jump with team-mate Mervyn Shalemba winning double titles in the Boys U/16 100m & 200m. Jamie Mitchell, Emerald A.C. won double titles in the Boys U/19 100m & 200m setting a new record in the 200m of 22.49 with **Tony Odubote, Ennis Track A.C.** winning gold in the Boys U/18 200m & 400m with a new 200m CBP of 22.35. In the middle distance events, Aidan Burke, Waterford A.C. won double titles in the Boys U/14 800m & 1500m with Conor Ryan, Templemore A.C. winning double gold in the Boys U/18 800m & 1500m and Niall Blackwell, West Waterford A.C. winning titles in both the Boys U/19 1500m & 3km. Joseph McEvoy, Nenagh Olympic A.C. won double gold in the Boys U/17 High Jump & 100mH with team-mate Sean Carolan winning 4 gold in the Boys U/17 Long Jump, Triple Jump, Javelin & Hammer. Ben Donovan, Abbey Striders A.C. won two titles in the Boys U/18 Triple Jump & High Jump with Reece Ademola, Leevale A.C. winning double gold in the 80mH and High Jump. Sean Mockler, Moycarkey Coolcroo A.C. won treble gold in the Boys U/18 Shot Putt, Discus and Hammer with his team-mate, Daniel Ryan winning 6 gold medals in the Boys U/19 110mH, Pole Vault, Long Jump, Shot Putt, Discus and Javelin. Shane Cawley, Waterford A.C. did the double in the Boys U/16 Shot Putt & Discus with Callum Keating, North Cork A.C. also winning on the double in the Boys U/14 Shot Putt & Discus. Shane Monagle, Tramore A.C. won double gold in the Boys U/18 Long Jump & 110mH with Wymin Sivakumar, Leevale A.C. taking treble gold in the Boys U/16 Long Jump, Triple Jump and 100mH.
