Munster Juvenile PRO Report


The Munster U/9 to U/11 Team Games \& the U/12 \& U/13 Track \& Field Championships were held in Lee's Road, Ennis, Co. Clare on Saturday $3^{\text {rd }} \&$ Sunday $4^{\text {th }}$ June 2017. There were lots of exciting performances with 4 new Championship Best Performances ("CBP") being set.

Details of the CBP's set over the weekend are as follows:-

1. Destiny Lawal Dooneen A.C. ran 51.43 in the Girls U/9 300m to smash the 2011 record of 53.94 set by Shauna O'Gorman, Kilmihill A.C.
2. Lewis Lenihan, Bandon A.C. threw the Boys $U / 10$ Turbo Javelin out to 21.74 m to better the existing mark of 21.64 m set by his club-mate, Eoin Cassidy in 2014.
3. John Murphy Liscarroll A. C. ran 1.42.81 in the Boys U/12 600m to smash the existing record of 1.44.00 set by Jack O'Connor, Dooneen A.C. in 2014.
4. Dooneen A.C. Boys U/12 $4 \times 100 \mathrm{~m}$ Relay ran 55.48 to take one second off the existing record of 56.48 set by Belgooly A.C. in 2015.

There were lots of great performances over the weekend some athletes taking more than one medal in their age group. Details of some of the multiple medal winners are below:-

Destiny Lawal, Dooneen A.C. won double gold in the Girls U/9 60m \& 300m also setting a new CBP of 51.43 in the 300 m ; Ryan Onoh, Leevale A.C. also did the double in the Boys U/10 60m \& Long Jump; Sarah Abullo, Waterford A.C. won double gold in the Girls U/11 Long Jump \& 600m; Lauren Shannon, Marian A.C. won silver in the Girls U/9 60 m \& bronze in the 300 m ; Ellie Kate McRae, Midleton A.C. won silver in the Girls U/9 Long Jump \& bronze in the 60 m \& Darragh Ball, St. Cronan's A.C. won double bronze in the Boys U/11 Long Jump \& Turbo Javelin.


In the Team competitions, Midleton A.C. duo Roisin McManus \& Meabh Corkery won double silver in the Girls U/9 60m \& 300m with Dooneen A.C. pair Maeve Purtill \& Ivana O'Carroll winning double bronze. In the Boys U/9 competition, Ollie Buckley \& Cathal Walsh from Riverstick/Kinsale A.C. won double gold in the 300 m \& the Long Jump. Carraig na bhFear A.C. pair Theo De Souza \& Sam O'Sullivan won silver in the Boys U/11 Long Jump \& bronze in the 60 m with Doheny A.C. duo Samuel Bailey \& Keith McCarthy winning double silver in the 600m \& Turbo Javelin.

In the Relays, Dooneen A.C. emerged as the strongest Club winning 5 titles out of 10 in the Girls U/9, $\mathrm{U} / 11, \mathrm{U} / 12$ \& $\mathrm{U} / 13$ \& Boys U/12 who also set a new Championship Best Performance of 55.48.
Midleton A.C. won gold in the Boys U/11 \& U/13 with Leevale A.C. winning gold in the Boys U/9 \& $\mathrm{U} / 10$ and Finisk Valley A.C. taking gold in Girls U/10.
