The Irish Life Health National Juvenile Games were held in Tullamore Harriers Stadium on Saturday 24<sup>th</sup> June 2017. There were 23 sets of team medals won by Munster (8 gold, 8 silver and 7 bronze). In addition to this, Munster Clubs also took home 7 sets of Relay medals (2 gold & 5 silver).

In the Girls U/9 Turbo Javelin, there was gold for **Hannah Doyle and Lucy Dennehy, Fanahan McSweeney A.C.**, while in the Girls U/9 60m, **Midleton A.C.** duo of **Ava Coughlan and Elle - Kate McRae** won silver with **Holly Harris and Ruby O'Neill, North Cork A.C.** also winning silver in the U/9 500m. The team of **Ava Coughlan and Elle -Kate McRae, Midleton A.C.** went one better in the Girls U/9 Long Jump to win gold with silver for **Belgooly A.C.** duo **Giselle Ahern and Lucy Swinburne**. Our Boys U/9 team of **Evan Naughton and Ezekiel Osabase, Leevale A.C.** won silver in the 60m with bronze for the **Lios Tuathail A.C.** team of **Ajay Barrett and Odhran Buckley** in the Long Jump.

In the Girls U/10 60m, there was gold for **Ali Dromey and Ava Hanley, Belgooly A.C.** and silver for **Ava Flavin and Lucy Nugent, Finisk Valley A.C.** and gold also in the Girls U/10 500m for **Heather & Rhia McCarthy, Doheny A.C. Templemore A.C.** team of **Grace Murphy and Kate Nevin** won silver in the Girls U/10 Turbo Javelin with two sets of medals for Munster in the Girls U/10 Long Jump with **Emma O'Connell and Ruby Cummins, Bandon A.C.** placing 2<sup>nd</sup> and **Limerick A.C.** athletes **Abbey Yelverton and Orlaith Grimes** winning bronze. In the Boys U/10 60m, Munster had two teams on the podium with gold for **Daniel Murphy and Ryan Onoh, Leevale A.C.** and bronze for **Matt Leyden and Enda Tormey, Derg A.C.** **Enda Tormey** scored another win in the Boys U/10 500m with his partner **Archie McNamara** taking gold in the U/10 500m with another gold medal for **Ryan Onoh, Leevale A.C.** with his team-mate **Mike Scott** in the U/10 Long Jump. **Andrew Lane and Lewis Lenihan, Bandon A.C.** won bronze in the Boys U/10 Turbo Javelin.
