

National Combined Events Titles for Lynch, Nevin & O'Connor



Munster athletes competed very well at the Irish Life Health National Combined Events Championships in Morton Stadium on Saturday 27th and Sunday 28th May 2017. With Day 1 experiencing torrential rainfall, the Pentathlon athletes were left with just a Quadrathlon on the day with the High Jump cancelled due to excess moisture and dangerous conditions on the run up. There were **8** wins in total by our athletes, 3 gold, 2 silver & 3 bronze. Our top athletes on the day were **Brian Lynch, Old Abbey A.C.** who took gold in the Youth Boys Decathlon with a score of 5832 points, **Diarmuid O'Connor, Bandon A.C.** who won gold in the Boys U/16 competition with 2945 points & **Harry Nevin, Leevale A.C.** who took the Boys U/14 title with 2807 points. Silver medal winners were **Orla Coffey, Carraig na BhFear A.C.** in the Girls U/16 competition (2064 points) & **Cillian Griffin, Tralee Harriers A.C.** in the Boys U/16 competition (2692 points) with bronze medals for **Anna Ryan, Moycarkey Coolcree A.C.** in the Girls U/16 (2062 points), **Susan Nestor, Nenagh Olympic A.C.** in the Girls U/15 (2265 points) & **Jordan Kissane, Tralee Harriers A.C.** in the Boys U/15 (2493 points). Other athletes who competed well but who were outside the medals were: -

Alex Reynolds, Nenagh Olympic A.C. – 6th Boys U/14 (1906 points); **Conor Callinan, Leevale A.C.** – 9th Boys U/14 (1674 points); **Amy O'Donoghue, Bandon A.C.** – 5th Girls U/15 (2022 points) & **Tristan Chambers, Bandon A.C.** – 4th Boys U/16 (2498 points).
